As part of our Courageous Advocacy work, Year 3 created a Kindness Tree to celebrate the small ways we can make a difference. Each leaf on our tree shows an act of kindness carried out by one of our pupils, from helping friends to caring for the environment.

Together we learned that being courageous advocates doesn't always mean doing something big – sometimes it's the little things we do each day that help make the world a better, more loving place.

To encourage children to recognise and celebrate acts of kindness in their daily lives — showing how small, caring actions can make a big difference to others and reflect Christian values of compassion and service.
