

### Topic – Big Wide World

This project teaches children about the global community to which they belong and how communities differ around the world.

We will explore different animal habitats around the world.

### PSHE – Relationships

### Foundations for phonics- Little Wandle

We will focus on the phonemes j/v/w/y/z/qu/ch

We will identify initial sounds of words and objects.

We will articulate sounds correctly and blend cvc words orally.

### Talk4Writing

The Very Hungry Caterpillar – a cumulative story. Learn the story and draw our own story maps. Retell to parents. Talk about the days of the week. Talk in longer sentences by using the word “but.” Non-fiction books about caterpillars and butterflies.

### Computing Purple Mash

To use the purple mash programme to support learning across the EYFS curriculum.

### Maths

#### Group recognition/subitising

To identify quantities of 4 things or less just by looking. Use language such as guess and match.

#### Classification - shapes

Compare and organise shapes. To talk about and explore 2D and 3D shapes. To use the words “sides” “corners” “straight” and “round.” Are there more/less/fewer/same/different/none?

#### 1:1 stable order and cardinality

Learning that we say one number for each object counted. There is a set of counting words that everyone uses and it never changes 1,2,3,4,5,6.
